

The Policy Driving of the Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province, Thailand

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Abstract

Creating the policy driving mechanism in different forms of each country, in order to meet the needs of people in the country who want to live well, have a good life, and be happy. Government agencies and various sectors have therefore come to play a role in helping to achieve maximum effectiveness. However, in the past to solve the problem, the balance was broken in areas where there were more than **10** million poor people whose incomes were insufficient and could not meet the standard of living expenses. Therefore, it is necessary to create a basic economic system or a community economy that has the characteristics of integration that is ready to develop the country, to strengthen the community, generate income, and make people happy with the policy driving of community strength. Therefore, this research aims **(1)** to study the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach. **(2)** to study the factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach. And **(3)** to study the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach. This research was conducted in Nong Khai Province. The sample was **400** people who voted in Nong Khai Province, A group of **10** key informants. The data were analyzed using mean and standard deviation statistics and multiple regression analysis. Qualitative data were analyzed using descriptive data. The results showed that:

1. The policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach overall in all aspects is at a moderate level. Considering each aspect, it was found that career development and income were at a moderate level. The financial and capital system, at a moderate level. The conservation of natural resources and the environment, at a moderate level. The Network Development, at a moderate level and welcome building, at a moderate level, respectively.
2. Factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in all aspects were not statistically significant at the **0.05** level, namely, role of the public sector, role of business sector, Community Leadership Roles, having a coefficient of The predictors in raw scores (b) were **2.102**, **.138** and **-.343**, respectively. Factor variables influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach at **0.05** level were civil servant role, local role. However, all variables together predicted the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach equal to **86.4%**, the forecast equal to ± 17121 ($F = 509.624$; p -value = 0.01).
3. The policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach includes development of financial and capital systems, career and income development, natural resource and environmental conservation development, welfare development, and network development..

Introduction

Distributed ledger technology is a technology that facilitates an expanding, chronologically ordered list of cryptographically signed, irrevocable transactional records shared by all participants to the network. Participants with the right access rights can trace back a transactional event, at any point in its history, belonging to any actor in the network. Technology stores transactions in a decentralized way. Value-exchange transactions are to be executed directly between connected peers and verified consensually using algorithms over the network. DLTs address a double-spending problem. Double spending problem refers to the fact that digital information can be copied using the internet e.g., somebody would send a digital asset like a digital paper of ownership of a car to someone else, then there is a risk that the sender

sends a copy over the internet and still keeps as the original paper of ownership (Thammavong, K., Kenaphoom, S., and Jedaman, P. 2021)

Thailand after the expansion of a capitalist economy that allows for business competition.

One of the major effects of globalization on the global economy is the intensification of business competitiveness. In addition, the world of globalization has caused factors that were previously not considered economic factors to have more influence on the economy. And not everyone is able to earn equal income, thus inequality of position arises. At the same time, Thailand is another country that is facing an increasingly serious problem of economic inequality. According to the Credit Suisse report on the wealth status of countries in the world in **2016**, The most worrying data is that Thailand has moved up from **11th** to the third most unequal country in the world after Russia and India (CreditSuisse, **2016:4**).

To make the nation stronger will be the beginning of the community enterprise in **2005**, The government has pushed for the Community Enterprise Promotion Act BE **2548**, resulting in the government's policy in solving the poverty of the people in the community, helping to reduce the burden of household debt. By allowing people to know how to use available resources to increase income to reduce socio-economic inequality, to distribute opportunities to create jobs and income to the countryside, to reduce immigration. Due to the concentration of economic activity in Bangkok, the central region, and the eastern region in some provinces where industrial estates are located, there is a problem of income distribution gaps between the sectors including the shift from farming to industrial sectors. From the above concepts pointed out that community enterprises are a component of the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and are an important economic activity in driving the community economy, creating a solid foundation for the country to obtain concrete support from the government. When the development of community enterprises is supported in accordance with the economic development plan as a solution to both internal and external economic and social problems. A rapidly changing country with a focus on development in accordance with the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy for the society to live together happily with equality, fairness and immunity to change and sustainable development (Lawanwong, S., and Sungrugsa, N., **2015: 1194**)

Based on the policies in the country's development plan, the government sector is encouraged by the development of various foundational economies. Community enterprises are a mechanism of civil state policy in driving the fundamental economy that the government gives importance, aiming to reduce inequality, build a strong community economy, happy people and increase income. The clarity of the plan is clearly stated within the Economic Development Plan that the country's development will continue to adhere to the principles of national development based on the philosophy of sufficiency economy, sustainable development, and people-centered development. Continually and adhere to the principles of economic growth that reduces inequality and drives growth through productivity-based productivity, wisdom and innovation. However, the management of community enterprises at present still has problems from weak government management, development mechanisms in each province and provincial groups still cannot link the work of relevant agencies. The public sector is large and its fixed expenditures continue to rise, but the public administration is inefficient, lacking a working system that is integrated into networks with other agencies or sectors. Public service must also be improved to meet international standards while corruption and misconduct has spread widely in both the public and private sectors. In addition, many laws are not of international standard because they are outdated and the enactment process still has many weaknesses, as well as the judicial process is inefficient and unable to provide equal justice, including the potential of the community enterprises themselves. There is a problem from the community (Sriboonruang,P.,**2013:27**). Especially, the agriculture has been the basic occupation of people in Thai

society for all ages. It is well known that Thailand is a country that is mainly agricultural and mainly farming. Therefore, the government needs to improve agricultural work first, the national economy will be better, the people will have better-living conditions (Chomsawat, S., and Pawala, T. 2021)

From the overview of the foundation economy in Nong Khai Province, it is very necessary to have the policy driving of the strength of the foundation economy according to the civil state guidelines, whereby the government has set a policy to develop communities to be strong, by laying out strategies and goals for people to have economic stability, and supporting the establishment of a service center for basic economic promotion to be a channel to link the use of resources from capital sources, production sources, market sources, and knowledge sources, both governmental and the private sector to develop the capacity for occupations that generate income for the community, In order to affect people at the village level to have economic stability and health care for themselves and their families by participating by relying on the Mekong River as a river that nourishes the people in the province who use it for farming for consumption consume and generate income for the community(Sittivongsa, B., Kunpalin, P., and Boonmee, K., **2019: 93**)

From the information mentioned above Therefore, the researcher is aware of the aforementioned problems and the importance of such a study, the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province, Thailand, in order to use it to develop and improve strategies for self-management, To build stability and strengthen community enterprises, in order to comply with the government's civil state policy and ensure stability for the economy of Thailand.

Objectives

1. To study the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.
2. To study the factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.
3. To study the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.

Methodology

In this research, the researcher uses an integrated research model using quantitative research. It is an exploratory research and qualitative research method using in-depth interviews with key informants by collecting information from relevant documents and research to draw conclusions about the factors influencing the policy. driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province at a confidence level of **90%**.

And all these numbers were obtained by multistage random selection, the population used in this study was **367,002** people who had the right to vote in Nong Khai Province.

The sample was the people who had the right to vote in Nong Khai Province, obtained by stratified random sampling from a large population with differentiated between random units that could be classified into stratified to provide information. that has been comprehensive and calculated the number of samples according to the Taro Yamane formula (Ymane, **1973:142**). The sample was **400** people who voted in Nong Khai Province (Wanichbancha, K., **2009:11**).

The key informants by interviewing from the selection of a specific sample, considering the informants who can provide knowledge, background, current conditions about the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province, divided into **1** group of **10**

people as follows: The target group used in the In-Depth Interview to determine the suitability and feasibility of the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province, divided into **1** group of **10** people by a selection method. Purposive sampling group according to the following features

1. Be involved in the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.
2. Being an executive at a senior level or above or a person involved in the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.
3. Expert on the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.

Research instruments include questionnaires used for quantitative research and interview forms used for qualitative research, questionnaire data collection:

1. Data collection using questionnaires, using questionnaires developed and improved to an acceptable quality to collect data by themselves and research assistants. The researcher asked for cooperation from people who have the right to vote in Nong Khai Province. Before the data collection, the researcher clarified about the details of the research objectives, the tools used for data collection, the data collection procedures and methods in order to provide the research assistants with complete and accurate information.
2. Asking for permission to collect data, the researcher created a questionnaire and made a letter of permission to collect data from the sample population.
3. The researcher brought a letter asking permission to collect data to the community leaders in Nong Khai Province to request permission to collect data, which is the population used in this study.
4. Distribute and collect questionnaires from the sample population.
5. Receive the questionnaire, check for accuracy and completeness, and then proceed to analyze the data.

Interview data collection The researcher conducted the interview data collection according to the following steps: **(1)** Study data from textbooks, research articles, research papers, including the explanatory part from textbooks, theoretical concepts, and related research by reviewing theoretical concepts related to the policy driving of community approach. Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province. **(2)** Data collection by using the research coordinator interview form to ask for permission from the group of informants by telephone and travel according to the scheduled date and time before the interview, the researcher introduces himself to create familiarity between the researcher and the interviewee. The purpose of the interview was to conduct an interview of **10** people.

Statistics used for data analysis, data analysis, questionnaires, after collecting the data from the questionnaires, the data were analyzed with a computer by using a statistical package for social science research as follows: (1) Analysis of the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province by using statistics of frequency, percentage, mean and standard deviation. (2) Analysis of factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province used multiple regression analysis using hierarchical variable selection method for discussion of results. (3) An analysis of the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach. The researcher used descriptive data analysis by selecting and classifying the data, organizing the data into a system, creating a

data editorial and analyzing the data, and then using the data to write a report according to the objectives of further research.

Interview data analysis: **1)** Analysis of documents, books, textbooks by reviewing concepts and theories related to the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province. **2)** Analyze and synthesize the data obtained from in-depth interviews from key informants as a conceptual framework in the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province.

Results

1. The policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province as the following table:

From Table 1, the general condition of the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach level in Nong Khai Province overall in all aspects was moderate (\bar{X} =3.26, S.D=.46). Considering each aspect, it was found that occupational development and income were at a moderate level (\bar{X} =3.09, S.D=.79). The financial and capital system were at a moderate level (\bar{X} =3.10, S.D=.26). The conservation of natural resources and the environment were at a moderate level (\bar{X} =3.08, S.D=.21). The network development was at a moderate level (\bar{X} =3.04, S.D=.25). And the welfare building was at a moderate level (\bar{X} =3.02, S.D=.83) respectively.

2. Factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province as the following table.

From Table 2, it was found that the factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach with statistical significance at the 0.05 level were the role of the public sector, the role of business sector, the Community Leadership Roles. The predictors in raw scores (b) were 2.102, 0.138, and -0.343, respectively.

The factor variables influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach with no statistical significance at the 0.05 level were Government role, and the local role.

However, all variables together predict factors that influence the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach equal to 86.4%, forecast equal to ±.17121 (F = 509.624; p-value =0.01)

3. The policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province found that

3.1 the financial and capital system, it is necessary to develop a financial system for people to have access to investment in management to strengthen the community, to be able to mediate and allocate economic resources to various economic sectors, as well as to settle There is an efficient, stable development in supporting the policy of strengthening the fundamental economy in accordance with the civil state guidelines for sustainable community growth.

3.2 Career and income development: It is necessary to develop professional skills in various fields to keep pace with market changes that are important for economic, social, educational, family. By applying innovative wisdom / technology to the production process that has been developed with goals in sales promotion, setting sales prices to create sustainable income for the community according to the civil state guidelines.

3.3 the conservation of natural resources and the environment, it is necessary to develop the wise use of natural resources and the environment, using less for maximum benefit, taking into account the length of use and the least harm to the environment including that there must be a universal distribution of natural resources by supporting the study of conservation of natural resources and the environment, theoretically correct, which can strengthen the community so that people are aware of the importance and necessity of conservation and serious cooperation in an economy based on the civil state approach

3.4 the welfare building, it is necessary to develop policies to help people in low-income communities by implementing the Civil State Welfare Project to reduce inequality, by enhancing the potential for low-income people to have a better life, stipulating that projects and welfare arrangements of the government to suit the community, Assistance according to the cost-of-living measures to strengthen the community according to the civil state guidelines

3.5 the network development, it is necessary to develop connections of people or organizations in the community that can exchange information together, or do activities together,

The structure of the community was organized to be equal under the basis of respect for the rights of trust and mutual care. In addition, building relationships and activities together in response to the policy of strengthening the community in the civil state approach seriously.

DISCUSSIONS

1. The policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach Overall, all aspects were found to be at a moderate level. Considering each aspect, it was found that occupational development and income were at a moderate level. The financial and capital system is moderate. The conservation of natural resources and the environment is moderate. Network Development is moderate. And welfare building was at a moderate level respectively. This is inconsistent with the research by Ngamwitrot, S. (2018:1). A study of people's response to the state welfare card policy: a case study of the Nakhon Chaisi community, Bangkok. The results of public opinion research on the benefits to be received from the state welfare card and the factors affecting the people's response to the state welfare card policy found that the overall picture was at a high level. When considered on a case-by-case basis, it was found that the first place was the problem of inequality in obtaining the right to register in someone else's name and obtaining a state welfare card at the highest level. In second place was the perception of information about the details of the state welfare card from media such as television, radio, newspapers, etc., at the highest level. Next, the third place was welfare for the elderly at the highest level. And the 25th lowest is getting a discount on water bills not more than 100 baht, and electricity bills not over 230 baht, at the moderate level respectively.

2. Factors influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach at 0.05 level were: role of the public sector, the role of the business sector, and Community Leadership Roles. In raw scores (b) were 2.102, .138 and -.343, respectively. The factor variables influencing the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach with no statistical significance at the 0.05 level were Government role, and the local role. However, all variables together predicted the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in Nong Khai Province 86.4%, the forecast was equal to ± 17121 ($F = 509.624$; $p\text{-value} = 0.01$) Consistent with research by Jintana, S.(2019:1) has studied the stability of the self-sufficient economy of community enterprises in Thailand. The results of the study concluded that external environmental factors and internal factors directly influence the work processes of community enterprises ($DE = -0.22$ and 0.94 , respectively). The results of the causal relationship path analysis of the level of self-reliance potential of

community enterprises in the central region of Thailand revealed that the context has a statistically significant negative direct influence on the self-reliance potential of community enterprises in the central region of Thailand.**01**. And internal factors (Input) and the work process of community enterprises (Process) had a statistically significant positive direct effect on the level of self-reliance potential of community enterprises in the central region of Thailand.**01**

3. The development guidelines of financial and capital system, It is necessary to develop a financial system that people have access to, to invest in management to build strength in the community, to be able to mediate and allocate economic resources to various sectors of the economy, as well as to make effective and efficient payments. Stability in supporting the policy of strengthening the fundamental economy in accordance with the civil state guidelines for sustainable growth in the community. In line with the research of Nawa, P.(**2018:1**), it examines the role of community leaders in sustainable economic development. The results showed that there are two types of roles of community leaders at different levels in the sustainable development of foundational economies: roles that differ according to their status and roles that are similar. Community leaders at all levels play a similar role in advocating, helping, and mediating participation, raising members' awareness of community ownership. Community leaders and community members are two important factors that can make a community develop. Although the community has good infrastructure, perfect community environment, sufficient community capital, but if the community leader does not attach importance to the development process and lacks cooperation from community members, the development will not be sustainable. Problems and obstacles in sustainable foundations economy development are community conflicts and people development problems that can't keep up with changes in the approach to sustainable foundation economy development, including: Leader's vision of being the core of the development and creating change for the community, the principle of participation, distribution of benefits and continuous development connected in all dimensions.

4. The development guidelines of career and income: It is imperative to develop professional skills to keep up with market changes that are important in economic, social, educational, family. By applying innovative wisdom / technology to the production process that has been developed with goals in sales promotion, setting sales prices, generating sustainable income for the community according to the civil state guidelines. This is consistent with the research of Nilwan, D. (**2012:1**) researched on participatory management for community business development in the Ban Dok Daeng sewing group, Sanga Ban Subdistrict, Doi Saket District, Chiang Mai Province. The results of the research revealed that the problems were management problems, marketing problems, production problems, and accounting and finance problems. From the above problems, there is a plan to develop a group management model of the group in **3** aspects namely attitude, knowledge, skills. As a result of the development of such members, the group is united and strengthened, the group management has been developed in the form of the Ban Dok Daeng Learning Center, which is the pride of the people in the Ban Dok Daeng community, resulting in sustainability. in community business development.

5. The development guidelines of conservation of natural resources and the environment, It is imperative to develop the wise use of natural resources and the environment, using them less for maximum benefit, taking into account the long use time and the least harm to the environment, as well as the distribution of natural resources. thorough. By supporting the study of conservation of natural resources and the environment, which can theoretically strengthen communities so that people realize the importance and need for conservation and cooperate in a fundamental economy. in the civil state. The results of this research are consistent with the research of Pinyapong, C. (**2012: 1**) research on the development of a holistic health care model according to the philosophy of sufficiency economy of the people of Laplae district, Uttaradit province. The results showed that the community had a similar lifestyle of self-sufficiency,

based on relationships and dependence on nature, the community health system was based on self-reliance, relying on traditional knowledge, wisdom, strengths about health wisdom, leading to a model of immunization, social support from all sectors, is the source of the development of alternative agricultural networks.

6. The development guidelines of The welfare building, It is necessary to develop policies to help people in low-income communities by implementing the Pracharat Welfare Project to reduce inequality by empowering low-income people to have a better life. Determine the implementation of projects and provide welfare of the government to suit the community by helping according to the cost-of-living measures. To strengthen the community in accordance with the civil state guidelines firmly. The results of this research are consistent with the research of Chumket, C., and Wongchinda, I. (2017:1) conducted a study on the need for welfare of the elderly in Saphli Subdistrict, Pathio District, Chumphon Province. The results of the research show that, overall, the elderly have a high level of welfare needs. When analyzing each aspect, it was found that the elderly gave priority to social security welfare the first place. This may be because low-income people feel the need for social security in accordance with Maslow's hierarchy of needs. This was followed by welfare in health services, possibly because low-income people lacked access to treatment, making it the second most important health impact. Income welfare because people with low incomes, having low salary, are not enough to spend on a daily basis 3. And the fourth place is recreational welfare which can cause all psychological stress. Therefore, recreational activities are one of the choices of people who want to be part of their daily lives, because nowadays, welfare, health security and life in a hurry make everyone in society see the more important and benefits in this area.

Especially, development of local government organizations under different laws to provide management to meet the needs of the people for better living. The development is based on policies that are in line with the needs of the local people. Local administration should take into account the principles of good public administration, which is regarded as the government's policy that requires good government agencies for the benefit of the people, resulting in the achievement of effective state missions, creating value for the state's mission, reduce unnecessary operating procedures, and the people are facilitated and their needs are met. As well as requiring regular assessment of government performance as a guideline for the performance of government services of local government organizations to facilitate and meet the needs of the people in each area. Public administration is efficient and worthwhile for the benefit of the people (Butprom, K., et al. 2021:13)

7. The development guidelines of Network Development, It is necessary to develop links among people or organizations in the community that can exchange information together, or do activities together by organizing the community structure to be equal under the basis of respect for the rights, trust, generosity each other both, build relationships and activities together to meet the policy of strengthening the community in the way of civil state seriously. This corresponds to the research of Chuayraksa, W. (2017:1) studied the guidelines for the development of community enterprises: a case study of the indigo-dyed cotton weaving group of Ban Tham Tao, Sakon Nakhon Province. The results of the research showed that there should be a strengthening and extensive cooperation network at the national level, for the expansion of the production and distribution sectors that are still relatively small, comprehensive production planning, raw material quality development, development of diversified product models to meet consumer needs.

Recommendation

Policy recommendations

1. The relevant government agencies should convert the contents of the Civil State policy or the implementation under the Civil State Mechanism into a simple language and communicate with the people in the area with the same understanding that the Civil State Mechanism is real in order to create an understanding with the community for the strength of the basic economy in a systematic way.
2. Units and sectors of all sectors, from local people, government agencies, private sectors and local governments, participate in the implementation of each project to achieve the goals according to the strategy and policy of strengthening the community in building The economy of the foundation of the civil state approach.
3. Government agencies should act only as mentors overseeing remote actions and creating policies or guiding and guiding the people, where the people play the main role, including brainstorming that reflects the design problems. Action activities and finding solutions to problems by themselves to build strength in the community and to drive the economy based on the effective civil state approach.

Practice recommendation

1. People's community leaders and community network partners must help each other drive the policy of strengthening the basic economic community by contributing to the development of community strength in all dimensions.
2. Should recruit networks from all sectors to join as volunteers to drive the policy of strengthening the community base economy, To create concrete participation together as the core to drive planning to solve problems and improve people's quality of life in a sustainable way.
3. There should be a basic economic community plan that is consistent with the community context, culture and local wisdom, including the appropriate use of resources available in the community, taking into account the future benefits and sustainability of the community strength that occurs. , Emphasis on listening to people's opinions primarily, able to help and develop the community to meet the needs of everyone in the community stably.

Further research recommendation

1. An in-depth study should be conducted by interviewing the methodology and applying a clearly structured action model in conjunction with the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach that is effective and concrete.
2. Should emphasize the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach with the participation of network partners to be used as a guideline or factor the policy driving of the community economic strength to be effective that is beneficial to the community.
3. Should study the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach, including planning, directing, and controlling. By the participation of various network partners in a structured manner in accordance with the policy driving of Community Foundation Economic Strengthening Based Civil State Approach in the future.

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
